

BAUS Section of Oncology, Southwest Public Health Observatory and HES data collaboration

Description

Data from the BAUS Section of Oncology, HES and Cancer registry data have been merged. This allows projects to be performed by NHS staff, usually supervised by a consultant urologist.

The available data will include data from the basic BAUS dataset and complex operations dataset, inpatient episode statistics and outcome in the form of death. For most projects a number of days work in Bristol will be needed.

Process for access to data

Proposal to BAUS Section of Oncology Executive committee.

A small subgroup comprised of Chairman, Secretary and Audit lead will decide on the clinical acceptability of the proposal, which if accepted, will be forwarded to Sean McPhail, at the Southwest Public Health Observatory, to ensure that the project is deliverable, based on availability of data.

If this is an accepted project, arrangements should be made through S McPhail to visit the Bristol centre to process the data. It will usually be possible to take unidentifiable data away. Access to data will be based on date application received and approved. It may be necessary to keep a waiting list if there are large numbers of applicants
